A: 14/12 and under 6 months, November 15 - May

Q: When and where are practices held?

A: Tuesday and Thursday night at 7-9 p.m. (practices vary according to gym)

Q: Sunday Play?

A: Molten VBC does not participate in any practices or tournaments on Sunday.

Q: Cost for Club fees?

A: 18/17/16/15 and under \$1,100 (5 months)

14/12 and under \$1,200 (6 months)

Cost includes: Uniforms, Balls, Carts, Registration fees, Team fees, Gym fees, Coach's fees and Administrative Operations, etc.

Q: Is fundraising available?

Q: Is playing time guaranteed?

A: No, playing time in tournaments is not guaranteed. Factors determining playing time will include attitude, attendance, punctuality, position, skill level and work ethic. It is our goal to give playing time to every athlete at every tournament, especially if they have exhibited the above traits.

Q: Can my child stop her membership in the club during the season?

A: Once you have committed to the club, you have committed to the entire season and the entire season's fees. It is very detrimental to the team when a player/parent decides in the middle of the season to leave the club. Further, it is unfair to any athletes that may have been cut from that team.

Q: Where can I find information regarding the next tournament?

A: The region website will post the tournament information on their website each Monday night prior to the scheduled tournament date. Tournament location sites will be in Tucson, Phoenix, or Prescott. Go to: www.azregionvolleyball.org

Q: How does my daughter get to her tournament?

A: Transportation to and from local or In-State Tournaments are the sole responsibility of parents/guardians. Due to liability concerns, coaches are not to provide transportation to any club event (i.e. meetings, practices, airport, tournaments, etc.)

Q: What happens if my daughter is injured during practice or a tournament?

A: The member's own personal insurance is considered the primary carrier in an event of an accident/injury. As a registered member of USA Volleyball, USA Volleyball provides minimal accident insurance coverage. This insurance is secondary coverage with a deductible. If the accident should occur, paperwork will be provided to the member, but Molten Volleyball Club/Molten Sports, LLC, USAV Arizona Region, nor Gilbert Public Schools will be involved further with the claim.

Q: How do I register with the USA Volleyball Arizona Region?

A: Go to: www.azregionvolleyball.org for detailed information. Click on "Join the Region" and follow the directions given. The process is not completed until the On-line Registration Form is completed and payment is mailed in to the AZ Region office.

All individuals must register or renew their Arizona Region tryout membership online for the 2012 season PRIOR to tryouts.

Q: What do I need to bring to tryout?

- 1) You must provide the club with your **confirmation page** that shows you have registered for the 2012 season in order to tryout with any club.
- 2) Please be sure to print and complete the "Medical Release Form" and all other forms listed on our tryout section.
- 3) New members to the Region must provide a photo copy of her birth certificate **if** not yet sent to the region office.
- 4) Tryout fee of \$20. Cash or make check payable to: Molten Sports
- 5) After being selected for a team, a \$350 commitment fee must be paid at tryouts to secure your position on the team. Failure to pay will result in a removal of your name from the list and an opportunity for another player to take her place on the roster.
